This Draft Test will be conducted in accordance with NCA Draft Test Regulations revised October 30, 1999, effective January 1, 2000; and updates effective February 23, 2006 and October 1, 2008.

Entries

Entries close **February 2, 2012 at 5:00 p.m.** at the home of the test secretary, at which time entries cannot be cancelled, altered, or substituted. Confirmation notices will be e-mailed by February 9, 2012.

Deadline February 2, 2012.

Entries postmarked before December 24, 2011 will be returned.

Entries are limited to 12. Entry fee is \$35.00 (single or team).

If the entry limit is exceeded by entries postmarked on the same day, a lottery will be used to determine the entrants to fill the available slots. An alternate list will be maintained by order of postmark date, and a lottery will be used for postmarks that are the same date. Note: Teams may not post-enter.

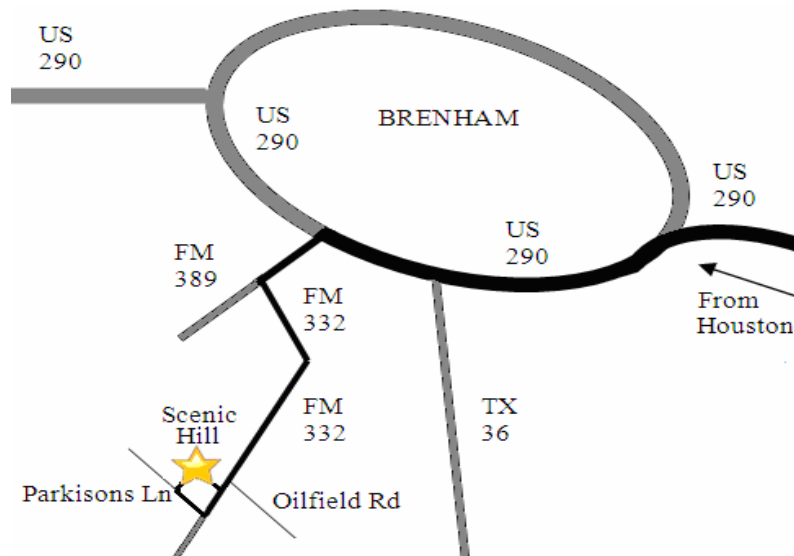

From the DRAFT TEST SITE/Jackson Street Park (2.5 miles/9 minutes)

- Exit parking lot – turn LEFT onto W. Mansfield
- At stop sign turn LEFT onto Jackson Street.
- Go 1.2 miles on South Jackson Street.
- Turn LEFT onto West Main Street.
- Go 1.3 miles on West Main Street (Business 290W).
- Turn LEFT into Brenham Veterinary Hospital.

From the Best Western Plus Inn of Brenham (4.6 miles/7 minutes)

- Exit motel parking lot – turn RIGHT onto Feeder Road.
- Take Hwy 290 West for 3.8 miles.
- Merge onto US-290W/West Main Street via the ramp to Austin.
- Continue to follow US-290 West for 0.7 miles.
- Turn LEFT into Brenham Veterinary Hospital.

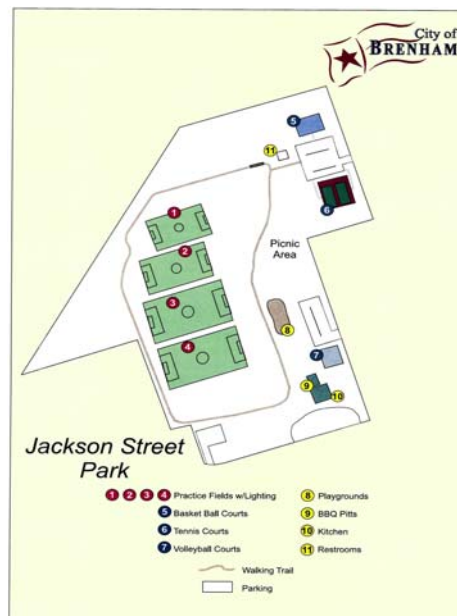
Directions to the Site

Jackson Street Park

West Mansfield Street

2.4 miles/7 minutes

- Leaving the motel parking lot, turn RIGHT onto the Feeder Road.
- Stay on the Feeder Road until the first STOP LIGHT.
- Turn RIGHT at the light onto Business 36 (South Day Street).
- Proceed on Business 36 (South Day Street) for 0.9 miles.
- Turn LEFT onto West Mansfield Street.
- Go straight on West Mansfield for 0.2 miles.
- Just after the first STOP SIGN, turn RIGHT into the Jackson Street Park parking lot.



About the Site

Old West Newfoundland Club's draft tests will be held at Jackson Street Park. OWNC has rented the covered pavilion with attached kitchen and bathrooms that borders West Mansfield Street at the southern end of the park.

The maneuvering course is in an area of trees and grass behind the pavilion. The freight haul will begin and end at the pavilion. Ground surfaces include grass, dirt, and cement. The freight haul includes natural terrain featuring gentle slopes, grassy plains, wooded areas, and a wooden bridge over a creek bed.

NCA Aggression Policy

The NCA Board has adopted the official AKC policy with regards to dog aggression for use at NCA working events, such as Water and Draft tests. That policy is as follows: “Any dog, that in the opinion of the Event Committee, attacks a person or a dog at an NCA working event, resulting in an injury, and is believed by that Event Committee to present a hazard to persons or other dogs shall be disqualified. When the dog is disqualified by the Event Committee pursuant to this section, a report shall be filed with the NCA Board. The disqualified dog may not again compete at any NCA working event, nor be on the grounds of an NCA working event unless and until, following application for reinstatement by the owner to the NCA Board, the owner receives official notification in writing from the NCA Board that the dog’s eligibility has been reinstated.” It is very important that each handler keep watch over his or her dog(s), to avoid any possible confrontation that might result in a Test Committee hearing on the matter, etc.

Important Notice For All Texas Dog Events

The State of Texas requires a once every 3-year rabies vaccination. All dogs three months of age and older must have a current vaccination. Tags do not constitute proof. A dog without a current rabies vaccination certificate is subject to 30 days quarantine.

Please remember to carry a copy of your dog’s current rabies vaccination certificate with you.

Entered dogs must be 18 months of age or older. Each exhibitor is responsible for his/her own draft equipment and freight haul load.
